Husson University's School of Pharmacy and the Academy of Student Pharmacists will be offering the 3rd annual "Pharmacy Summer Camp" July 25-27, 2012 for up to 15-20 Maine high school students who will be juniors or seniors during the 2012-2013 academic-year and are interested in pursuing a career in pharmacy. The total cost of the one-week camp is covered by a diversity scholarship funded through Walgreen's Corporation.

To be eligible to attend student should meet the following criteria.

- Represent an ethnic minority or be from an economically disadvantaged family (desirable but not required).
- Have completed (or be scheduled to take during their senior year) Algebra II, Biology and Chemistry.
- Have a high school GPA of 3.0 or better.
- Be interested in pursuing a career in pharmacy.

To apply, students must submit the following application materials (electronic submissions are acceptable) in the order indicated, no later than April 13, 2012 to:

- A cover sheet with: student's name, home address, home phone number, email address, high school, and high school counselor.
- A one-page essay (double-spaced, Times New Roman font) on how he/she meets the criteria for the diversity scholarship and why he/she is interested in the program.
- A one-page letter of recommendation from a science or math high school faculty member.
- A copy of his/her high school transcripts.
- A chronological list of all extracurricular activities during the past three years.

Final selection of camp participants will be made by a committee composed of students from the Academy of Student Pharmacists and all applicants will receive written notification the week of May 1st, 2012 as to whether or not they have been selected.
