Advanced Placement courses are available in Studio Art: 2-D Design, Studio Art: Drawing, Biology, Chemistry, Calculus B/C, Statistics, English Literature and Composition, U.S. History and Government. Honors Challenges are also offered in all 9th grade core classes.
